TREBAS STUDENT PORTAL Multi-Factor Authentication Set-up Guide



WHAT IS MFA?

Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) is a powerful shield that adds an extra layer of protection to your Trebas accounts while remaining user-friendly. It seamlessly combines your password with secondary authentication on your mobile device, such as your smartphone or tablet. By responding to an application (app) message, SMS text message, or email, you confirm the legitimacy of any login request to your account. With MFA in place, even if someone gains access to your password, they won't be able to enter your account without the MFA component, ensuring your data remains secure.





Getting Started



This guide provides step-by-step instructions on how to set up MFA using the Google Authenticator application (app) and SMS text message, how to login to the Trebas Student Portal after MFA has been set up, and how to change MFA methods.

If you are setting up MFA outside of Canada with a phone number that is not connected to a Canadian SIM card, you will not be able to authenticate your Trebas Student Portal login account via SMS text message from within Canada.

Instead, set up the Google Authenticator app as your primary MFA method. You will be able to change your method of authentication to SMS text messaging once you have a Canadian SIM card.

After setting up MFA, you will receive a prompt via the Google Authenticator app on your device to approve any sign-in attempt to your Trebas Student Portal account. By responding to the Google Authenticator verification request or an SMS text message, you confirm that the login attempt to your account is authorized.



Logging in
